

## PASTORAL PONDERINGS




Nature invites us to consider the spirituality and transformative power of God. Engaging in nature gives us rest and time for contemplation. Nature has the power to change us and to shift our perspective on what we thought we knew and understood about life. Nature has the ability to bring the great truths of being Easter People to life! The cosmic story of Jesus Christ's divine conception, his hidden ordinary life, his abandonment, rejection, crucifixion, death, resurrection and ascension is continuously taking place everyday and in every moment. The Good Shepherd reminds us to pay attention.



Recently, I traveled with a friend to her sister's sheep farm and experienced three days of the lambing season. What laid ahead was filled with the story of what being Easter people is all about. God's goodness through this experience brought new life and deeper meaning to the deepest truths in our faith.

We arrived at the farm, which is located in a desert valley, about 11:30pm. We dropped our bags off in the bungalow and went out to check on an ewe who was experiencing some problems with her pregnancy. She was in labor with no sign of delivery so Terry, my friend and the owner of the farm, slipped into vet mode and entered the lamb to assist the mom with delivery. There were four lambs in the ewe and they were all tangled up. The first was delivered and handed to me. Since the lamb was not breathing I was instructed to remove any blockage from its mouth and then was told to hold it upside down and swing it back and forth and slap its sides to try to get the lamb breathing. The 2nd, 3rd, and 4th lambs were delivered with the same problem. The three of us were unsuccessful in our efforts of trying to help the lambs take their first breath and on top of that, their momma died during labor. We went to bed with heavy hearts.

Morning came and brought with it sounds of sheep, chickens, guineafowls and hope for a better day. Breakfast was prepared on the open fire and the two families camping on the farm for a lambing experience joined us. As we all walked toward the fields containing the pregnant ewes, we passed the fields containing the new lambs with their moms. This brought great joy! As we entered the field, there was a ewe down on her side in labor. She did require some assistance but we were happy to welcome heathy twins who were named Buttercup and Bolder!



Even though the lambing season had been very successful up until the night before, later that day there was another loss. The ewe needed some recovery time due to her difficult delivery and the loss of her lambs. She was put in a pen and provided with two lambs. One was a preemie who had been bottle fed by a neighbor for a couple weeks and the other lamb was rejected by her mother. I am happy to share the two lambs (Maxi and Mini) are flourishing and mom is physically stronger and in much better spirits! These experiences

were filled with sorrow due to death and joy due to new life. It was both/and.



As we celebrate Easter, as resurrection people, may we receive and keep hope alive through the cultivation of gratitude; especially during the difficult times. Let us open our eyes and ears to the voice of the Good Shepherd who is always calling us. As we spiral toward heaven with each liturgical year, let us pray

to become more aware of how the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ plays out in our day to day lives. The feeling of doom that is often the focus in our culture, along with the ups and downs within our personal and family lives, can at times make it hard to say: "Death no longer has the final word." The challenge of being resurrection people is to continually listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd; especially while waiting in the darkness for new life to come. God is faithful. Resurrection is filled with grace, possibility, and new life! Let us receive and share this Good News!



#### **Mission Trip Update:**

#### Casa Hogar Juan Pablo II Orphanage Lima, Peru

The trip is an incredible opportunity to be a servant of God to the poorest of the poor.

In July we will travel to experience firsthand the incredible work being done at Casa Hogar. We will be the hands, feet, face and heart of Jesus as we travel the impoverished streets of Peru while learning more about Faith, Hope and Love. We will work with the 64 orphans at the Orphanage!

To do this we need your prayers and support. Here is an update on our planning and breakdown of some of our costs:

- Flights are booked through Delta-\$1264.85 each, we fly out on July 14 and will have a mission team blessing at the Saturday evening Mass.
- We will all take three suitcases: a carry-on with 10 days worth of personal clothes and supplies and two checked suitcases with mission trip supplies and donations. The first suitcase cost is included in our flight, the second one is \$100!

Volunteers stay and eat at the orphanage: housing at the orphanage is \$175 per participant.

Thank you so much for the donations we have received so far. We truly appreciate it!!







